Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT) - A Global Financial Hub GIFT city aspires to cater to India's large financial services potential by offering global firms a world-class infrastructure and facilities. It aims to attract the top talent in the country by providing the finest quality of life all with integrated townships, IFSC and multispecialty special economic zone (SEZ). The site is 12 KM from the Ahmedabad International Airport and 8 KM from Gandhinagar.

Semester II & IV students of Anand Institute of Management went on an industrial visit to visited Kalpataru Power Transmission Ltd, Gandhinagar and Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT), Gandhinagar accompanied by three faculty members (Prof. Shivani Shah, Prof. Akash Shah and Mr. Narayan Pandya) on **5th February, 2016**. We reached at 2:00 pm at Gift city, where Mr. Chandresh Kapadia (Sr. HR Executive, GIFT CITY) came to receive us at gate and he directly took us for Gift City visit. Gift city is spread into 886 acres of land. Currently two towers' construction is over and started its operations. The gift city plant visit covered **Water Supply & Sewerage System, District Cooling System**, Data Base, petrol pum, Narsinh Munji School, SEZ area and many more places at GIFT. After the visit of plant he took us to the cafeteria of

Gift City and showed small documentary of GIFT project which gave more clear idea of GIFT projects to students. Even he shared future plans of projects. After that we were served with hi-tea. Around 4:00 pm we had completed both industrial visit and we left from Gift city, Gandhinagar to Anand. We visited kakariya on the way situated at ahmendabad.
