Sanitary Napkin, a universally needed product, has a very low penetration in India and other developing countries, partly due to its high price and due to the tradition of using cheaper unhygienic old cloth. As a result they became the host of many infectious diseases.



Generally going to a medical store for sanitary napkins is not possible all the time. To aware the female students about the usage of the Sanitary napkin vending machine, implanted at Anand College of legal studies, Anand along with faculty members 35 female students went there for the demo of a coin operated automatic vending machine which can efficiently dispatch sanitary napkins for immediate demand, it is a hygiene absorbent product used by women during menstrual periods.

Sanitary Napkin vending machine is also a dispenser machine, as & when women require a sanitary napkin just by doping a coin, press a button it will give a new sanitary napkin to her. Sanitary napkin destroyer is sanitary napkin burning machine, just open the door of destroyer, put used sanitary napkin inside, press a button, which will burn the used sanitary napkin within minute make a starlit ash.

- Switch on the main power supply of machine.
- Green indicator=machine is ready for process.

- Open the door and carefully drop the used napkin inside and tightly close the door.
- Push the green start button on the panel to start process.
- Red indicator=process started.
- This process will run for 10 minutes and will stop automatically, so no need to wait.

The whole process was explained by Dr. Bindiya Soni, I/c Director of Anand Institute of Management to all the female students. All female students were aware about the upgration of new technology of buying the sanitary napkins were needed.
